

KEILOR PARK CRICKET CLUB CODE OF CONDUCT

Introduction:

Keilor Park Cricket Club is committed to providing a positive and inclusive environment for all its members. This Code of Conduct sets out the standards of behaviour expected from players, coaches, officials, and spectators associated with the club. By being a part of The Keilor Park Cricket Club Inc, individuals are expected to adhere to the principles outlined below.

Players:

- a. Respect opponents, teammates, coaches, officials, and spectators.
- b. Play within the rules and within the spirit of the game.
- c. Accept decisions of the umpires without argument or dissent.
- d. Be punctual for all training sessions, matches, and other club events.
- e. Encourage and support fellow players, irrespective of performance.
- f. Avoid the use of foul language, sledging, or any form of verbal abuse.

Coaches:

- a. Promote fair play, teamwork, and sportsmanship.
- b. Provide constructive feedback to players for their development.
- c. Treat all players with respect, regardless of skill level.
- d. Ensure the safety and well-being of players under their supervision.
- e. Lead by example, both on and off the field
- f. Encourage players to win with humility and lose with grace.

Officials

- a. Uphold the rules of the game and make decisions impartially.
- b. Treat players, coaches, and spectators with respect.
- c. Attend ongoing training to stay updated on rule changes and interpretations.
- d. Maintain control of the game, preventing and managing any misconduct.
- e. Report any incidents promptly and accurately.

Supporters

- a. Support all participants, regardless of the team they represent.
- b. Refrain from using offensive language or engaging in disruptive behaviour.
- c. Respect the decisions of the officials, even if you disagree.
- d. Encourage a positive and inclusive atmosphere at matches.
- e. Set a positive example for younger spectators.

Disciplinary Procedures

- a. Any breaches of this Code of Conduct will be referred to the Committee for review
- b. Penalties may include warnings, suspensions, or expulsion from the club, depending on the severity and recurrence of the misconduct.

Reporting:

- a. Incidents or concerns should be reported to the club committee or designated welfare officer promptly.
- b. Confidentiality will be maintained throughout the investigation process.
